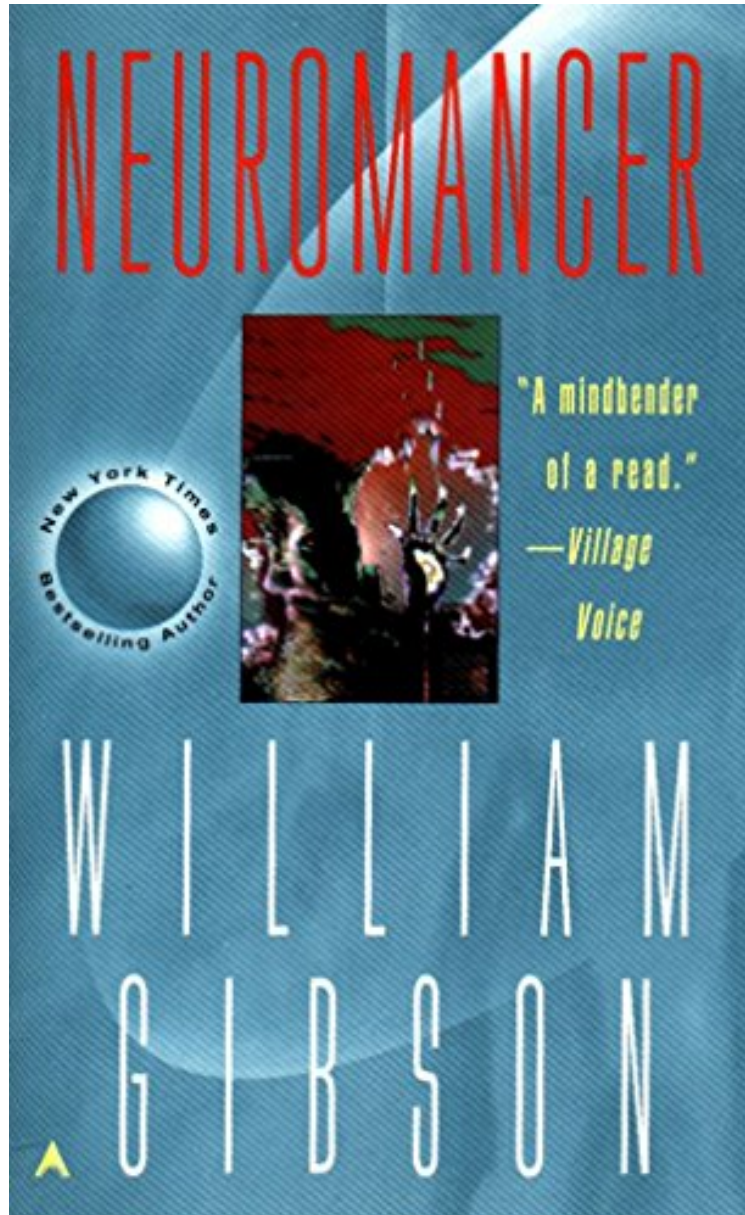

and after some research decided on buying this book. Unfortunately it did not live up to my expectations. Some of the aspects seem to not be entirely thought through (which I think is a necessity in sci-fi/cyberpunk and related subgenres) and the characters lack vividness. Descriptions (e.g. of how ICE works) are vague and do not engage the reader. If you are looking for a book that can enchant you and have you forget time while reading it, this is not it (unfortunately, because I think the topic is a great one). I can't quite put a finger on what bothers me about the writing-style, but I oftentimes found myself re-reading whole passages and had to look some stuff up on the neuromancer wiki, as they weren't explained well in the book. I found myself really taking a long time to finish this book (I am not a quitter ;)) and won't be buying the rest of the trilogy. The topic itself is very interesting and in my opinion an important one to get engaged in, I would say that this book definitely put me on my path to do some research on current AI projects, which I am thankful for.
