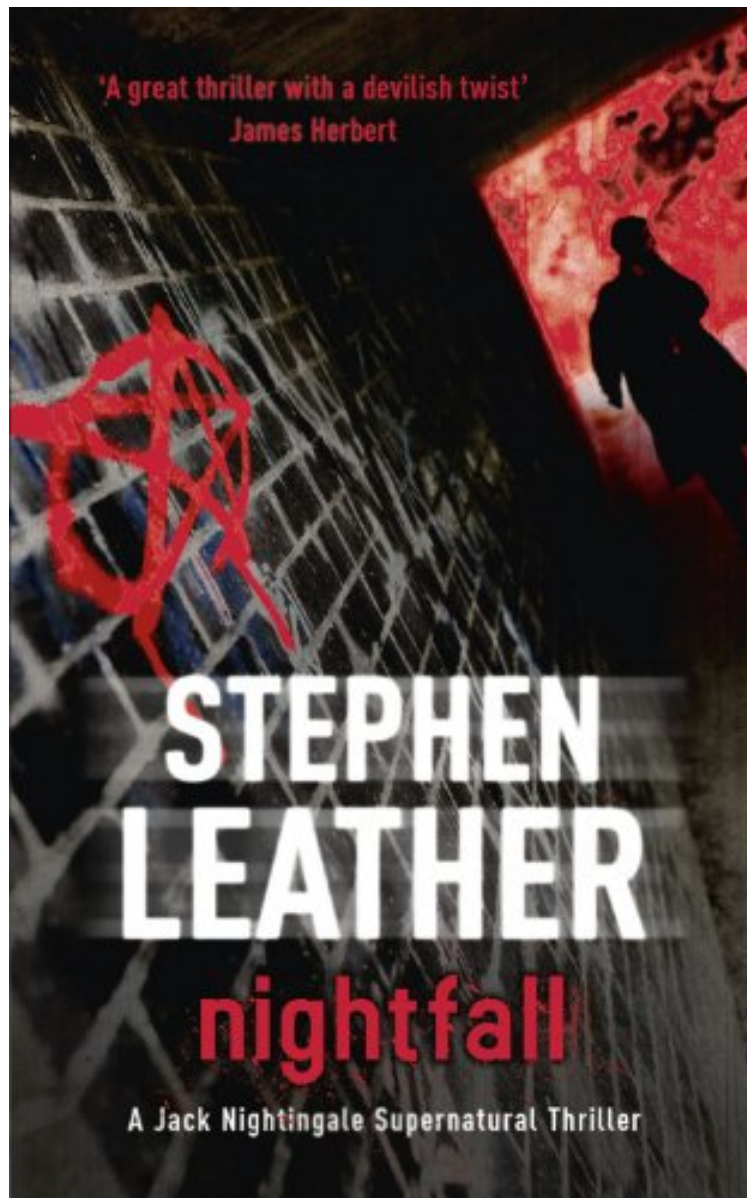

Von Charles Halloway "You're going to hell, Jack Nightingale!". Diesen Satz hrt Jack Nightingale, Privatdetektiv und ehemaliger Polizist, am Anfang noch ohne ihm Beachtung zu schenken. Doch bald verdichten sich die Hinweise, dass genau das an Nightingales nchstem Geburtstag passieren wird. So macht sich Jack auf die Suche seiner nicht gekannten Vergangenheit und versucht das anscheinend Unvermeidliche zu stoppen. Leather Geschichte ist direkt, verfolgt den Plot ohne groe Abschweifungen. Die Personen sind sympathisch und weitestgehend glaubwrdig. Vor allem Jenny, Nightingales Assistentin, drfte Stoff fr eine Fortsetzung hergeben (diese erscheint wahrscheinlich; dennoch handelt es sich um einen abgeschlossenen Roman ohne "Kaufverpflichtung" der (mglichen) Fortsetzung). Der Autor bewegt sich mit Nightfall im Bereich des Mystischen und Okkulten. Das gelingt ihm ordentlich, sodass man ihm die doch recht phantastische Geschichte abnimmt. Wie schon gesagt, die Geschichte ist gradlinig, spannend und ohne Durchhnger, und luft auf ein interessantes Finale hinaus. Aus meiner Sicht spannender Lesestoff, der auch auf Englisch gut zu verstehen ist; Leathers Sprache ist hier doch recht eingngig. Einen Punkt Abzug fr Leathers nervige Wiederholungen bezglich Nightingale Rauch- und Trinkgewohnheiten. Keine Ahnung, was damit bezweckt werden soll, es nervt auf Dauer aber einfach.
