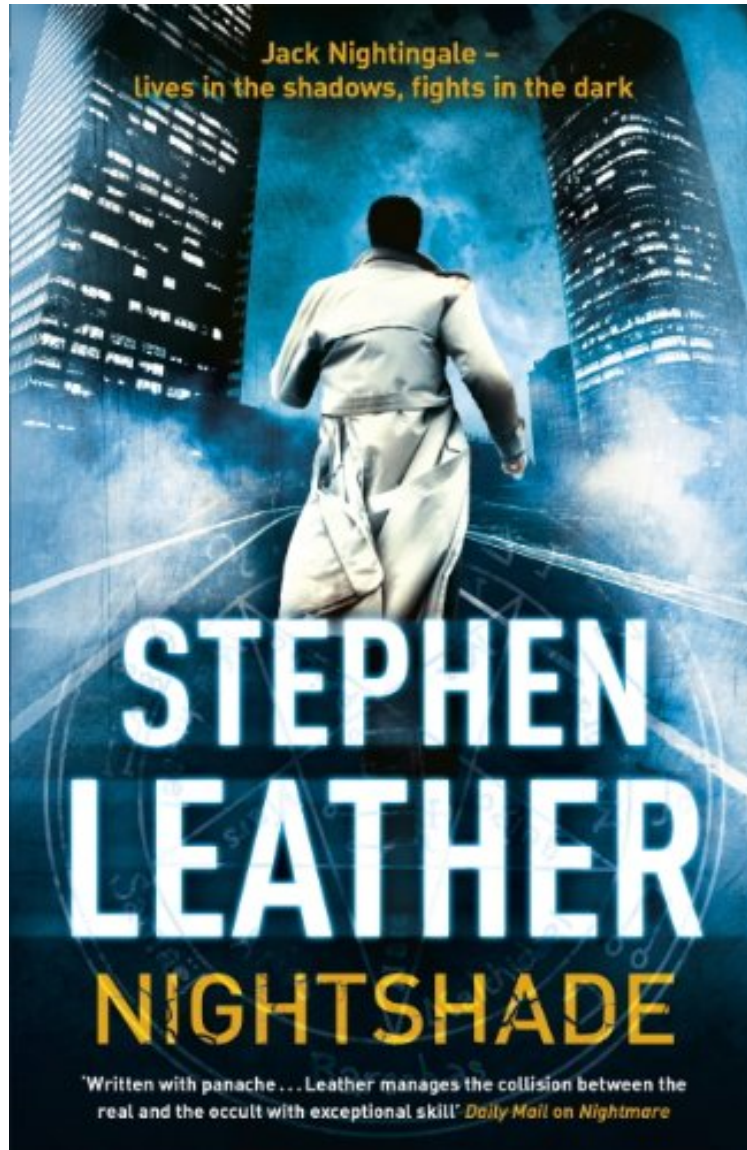

And so an hearthy "Welcome" to the world of Jack Nightingale, where reality and occult collide and everyone has to keep his or her soul very closely to her- or himself... A farmer, bachelor and loner one morning walks into a school and shoots a teacher and eight children, before he eats his rifle. A SWAT team arrives, late, and has only nine bodies to give to the parents. An open-and-shut case - until on the farm in a barn there's found evidence of Satanic practices. But here the case comes knocking on Jack's door. The brother of the shooter is adamant that his brother was set up. And Jack Nightingale takes the case because there's something that stinks to high heaven. Then a nine-year-old girl is abducted, but dies in the process of liberation. When the paramedics look at her, she miraculously returns to life, and says she has messages from Jesus and the Otherworld. But when the bodies around the little girl start to accumulate, Jack is confronted with the hardest decision he's ever faced. So our hero has to resolve two very complicated cases and - as always - his soul is in peril to go to HELL... because he sometimes has to rely on 'partners' who are themselves a bit 'under- or otherworldly' :) A perfect read, a real 'tour de force', and a true MUST for all friends of supernatural thrillers in general and specifically of Jack Nightingale.
