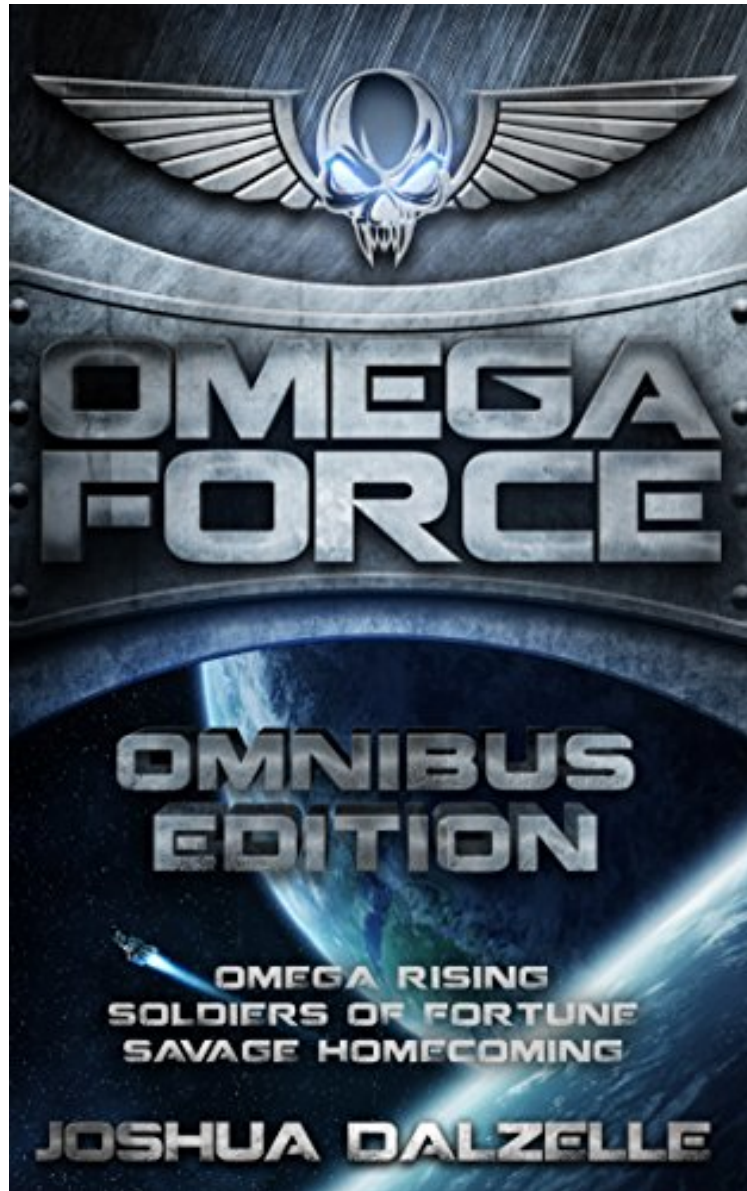

In this case I gladly spend it though, because Mr. Dalzelles series took me by surprise and showed itself as utterly entertaining. I won't pretend that this is high literature, it is not. It is nevertheless great fun to read, spiked with lovable characters, nice plots, a great "seventh" crew member in form of the ragtag crew's space ship and just genuinely good stories about the somewhat roguish but selfless heroes of Omega Force (read: A-Team in space). If you enjoy your dose of soft sci-fi action adventures with enjoyable if not overtly complex plots, but lots of winks, tongue-in-cheek moments, outright hilarious scenes and some dramatic action sequences, you're about to get hooked here. I was instantly, in fact so much so, that I went through six of the seven books in existence in just over three weeks. Get your kicks and read this.

Fun but simple Von Tobias Sippl Book 1: Personally I liked this one the best, as it introduces a lot of characters, technology and the universe itself. So it feels fresh. The biggest letdown to this book are the really weak finale, which feels like it's grafted onto the end so the book isn't too short and every main character does at least something. The way the main story plays out is also pretty weak but who cares. It's supposed to be a fun light book. Book 2: Feels like the author had an idea in mind, an infiltration of a covert organization. Unfortunately the infiltration is mostly based on luck (multiple times in a row) so it feels like it's pieced together. The finale of this book makes literally no sense. HEAVY SPOILER ALERT: The evil guys (you don't really learn more about them in this book) want to crash an orbital platform which is anchored to a planet, into said planet. To do that they attack the base station and start winding the platform in. Luckily one of our characters in the last moment discovers that there's a button in every room of the facility to release the anchor. Why nobody in the facility or orbital platform released it before they were all killed does not get answered. Pretty lame deus ex machina right there. Book 3: Earth is under attack. They have to run around the galaxy in the hopes to capture the evildoer. Not gonna go into detail here, but this book had a pretty decent opening only to really bore you after. The finale is a pretty lame chase around earth. Imagine reading a few pages of someone listing what cities they just flew over. The worst of this book is probably his cliché girlfriend from earth who doesn't do anything besides being there. Overall the main character of the book is inconsistent. Keeping his cool, not keeping his cool. Being a nerd, not being a nerd. He just changes so his reaction fits the story. Most planets they visit are the same (hey it's the space age, every second planet is there to be mined instead of uninhabited planets/asteroids). The author describes a lot of tech, then rarely puts it to use in the story which disappointed me a bit. The writing is really subpar at times (reading seat/seated 4 times over 2 sentences is too much). Rated individually I'd rate the first book at 4 stars, the second at 3 and the last at 2. I bought this after reading Warship from the same author, but written more recently, so I wanted to give this a chance. The author definitely got better, even though some of the flaws are still in there (mainly the repetition of very noticeable words).
