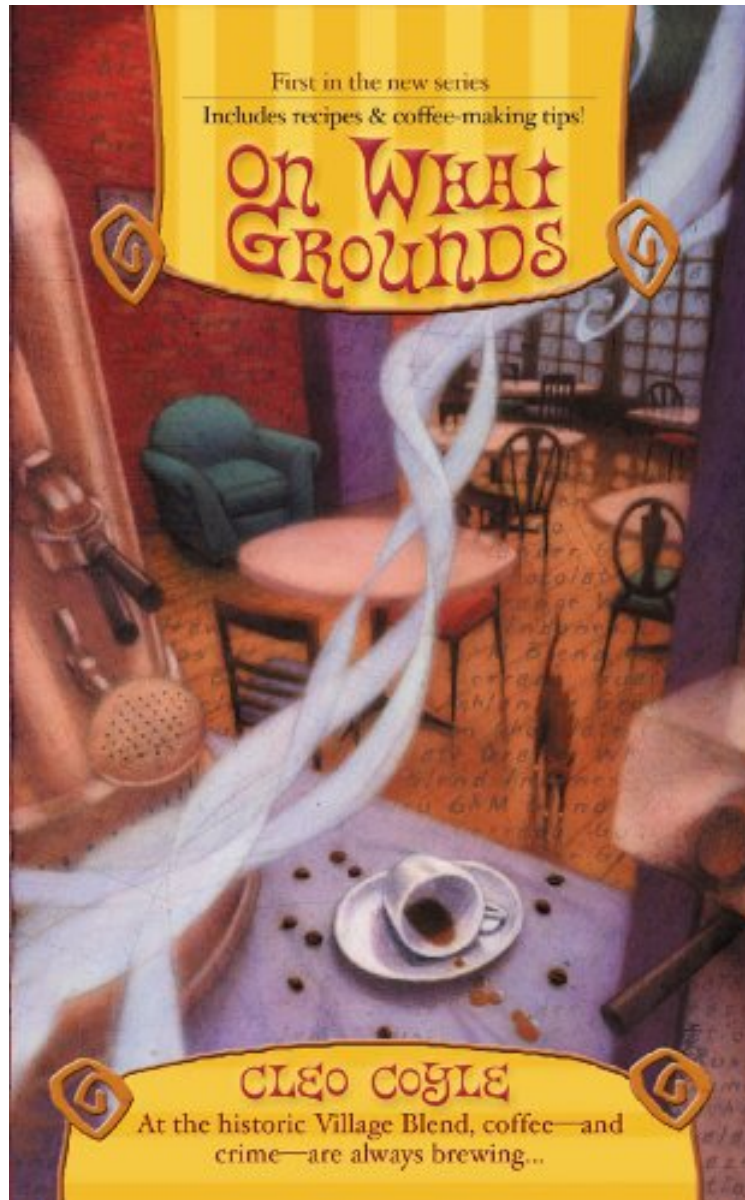

The synopsis sounded good, however "On what Grounds" was not only good but great: Upon request of "Madame" - the owner of the historic coffee house "The Village Blend" Clare Cosi returns to NYC's Greenwich Village to manage the Blend after a ten-year absence. When she comes to work one morning she finds her assistant manager's body lifeless at the bottom of a pair of stairs to the basement. The police rule the incident as an accident quite quickly, but since Anabelle was a dancer, Clare thinks it rather unlikely that she would stumble and fall. Therefore she starts a little investigating on her own... Besides the trouble Clare gets herself in while gumshoeing, her ex-husband is apparently residing in the cozy apartment on top of the Blend as well. Hardly irresistible Matteo is the Blend's long-term and only coffee-importer as well as Madame's son and Madame had figured out plots before to get Clare and Mat back together.... Result: I could almost smell the coffee and dwelled in the atmosphere Coyle created in her debut. I'll definitely have to try out the coffee-recipes and get the next two books in this series ;-)

The other half got her former husband Matteo. At Clare's very first day she found her assistant manager Anabell lying at the bottom of a stair. Fortunately, she still breathes but it does not look good. The police investigate and come to the conclusion that it was an accident. But Clare disagrees. She looks for hints on her own and found out some very suspicious facts. This is the first book of a sequel of recently six cosy crimes written by Cleo Coyle, who is actually a team. The couple Alice Alfonsi and Marc Cerasini write about the owner and her staff of The Blend. The cover with its warm brown colours invites to sit down for a hot cappuccino. Then you can read about Clare, her ex-husband Matteo, his mother only called Madame, their daughter Joy and some of the baristas. Of course there is also something for the heart included. Clare often flirts with Lieutenant Quinn and it is interesting to see where it goes. Nevertheless, the man is already married. Furthermore, it is a nice idea to enclose various receipts for some drinks and the dessert, when Joy brought her boyfriend to her parents. So the reader can even smell the special situation at home when following the case. This debut catches the reader until the end. Even if we suggest how it ends, the story gets a turn on the last pages. This book will be continued by "Through the grinder". I really can recommend this crime to everybody who does not need much blood to feel entertained.
