I thought that Angie McCaffrey's work in an advertising agency was the start of a tale where her whole life was turned upside down by a vampire and she ended up haunting the night or something. Instead the tale continues in the Ad agency with the vampire aspect fairly minor to

the story - it's more of a whodunnit instead. Angie discovers that her boss Lucy is dead and can't help linking Lucy's death with the strangely compelling man she's recently met at a vampire club. What is it about Eric that draws her so much? When she realises that Eric may be trying to turn her into a vampire too she has to decide whether that's what she wants - and whether Eric is an evil killer or perhaps something different. The writing style of this book was light and easy-to-read but I felt the characterisation was a little suspect - I didn't ever feel very closely engaged with Angie, despite the book being written in the first person, and Eric was very nebulous indeed. The book ended with hints that there may be others to come but I felt it wasn't wrapped up entirely to my satisfaction and I won't be hunting out the sequel.
