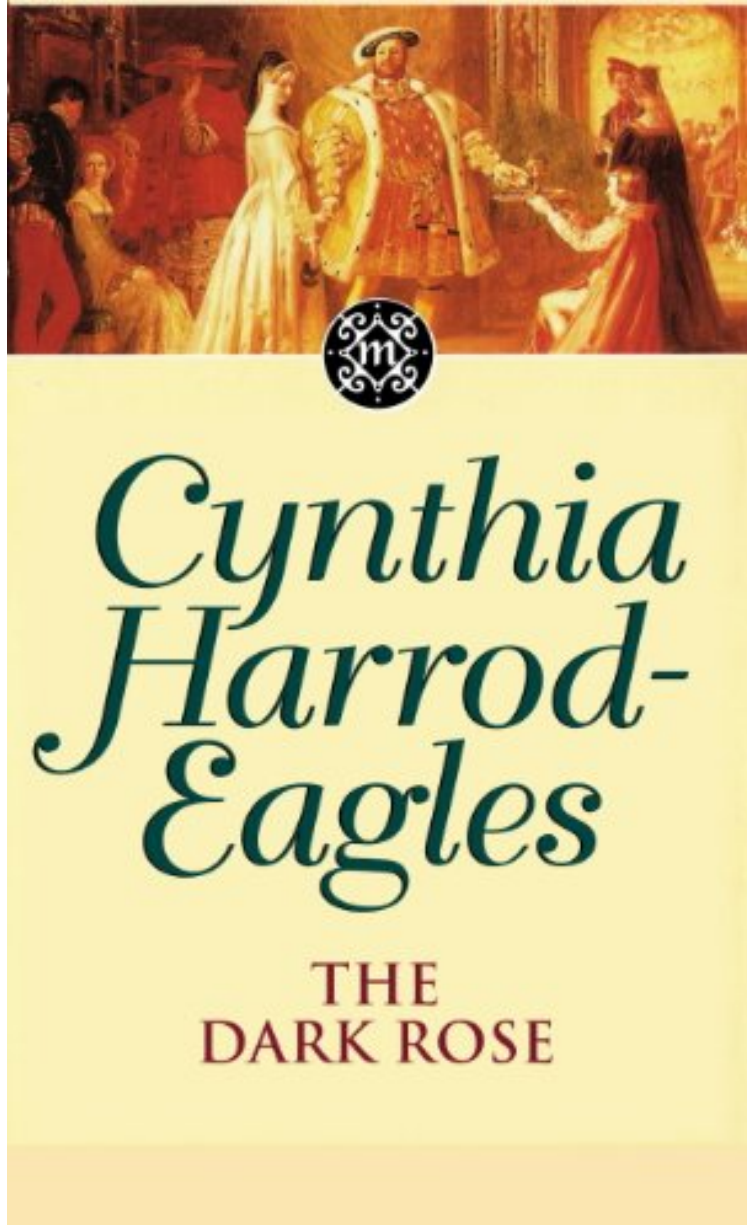

His selfish, although genuine, love for a lovely peasant woman and his uncaring attitude towards his bastard son Adrian result in anguish, violence and death, but also in the establishment of a new branch of the powerful Morland family. At the same time, Ralph's clever and beautiful niece Nanette witnesses the turbulent years of Henry VIII's reign first as lady-in-waiting to Anne Boleyn and then to Katharine Parr. For her, duty always comes first. Only after Katharine's death does Nanette realize that her future and happiness lie at Morland Place. To ensure the peace of mind of her loved ones, she has to try at all costs to keep the parentage of her adopted son Jan a secret.
