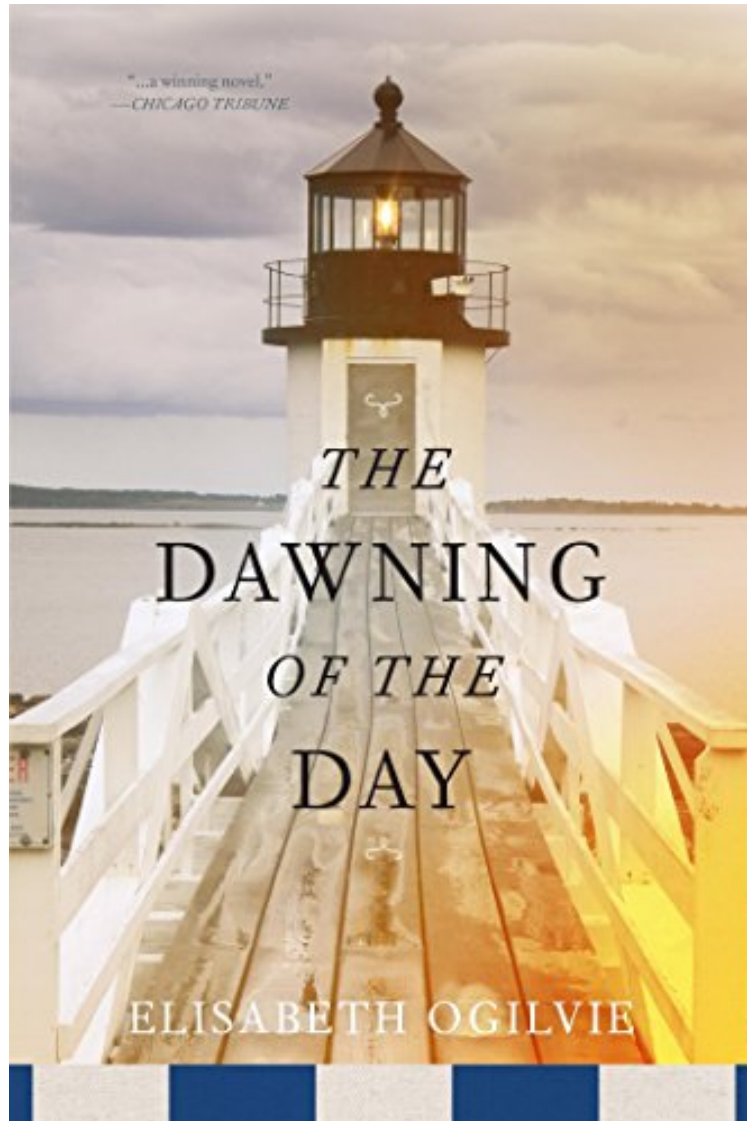

But Ogilvie did it again: "The Dawning of the Day" keeps you reading from the first page to the end and makes you forget everything around you.This time, the story

is not about Joanna Sorensen ne Bennett in the first place, but about widowed teacher Philippa Haworthy who has taken up a job on the island in order to earn her and her son's living. Seeing to justice being done in her small schoolroom she slips into a right-out lobster war head over heels. As the war breaks up families, turns others breadless and ruins Philippa's reputation, there is a tender love story going on between the teacher and Steve Bennett. The ending is a bittersweet one, mixing Philippa's happy ending in marriage with the death of three islanders, among them a Bennett.
