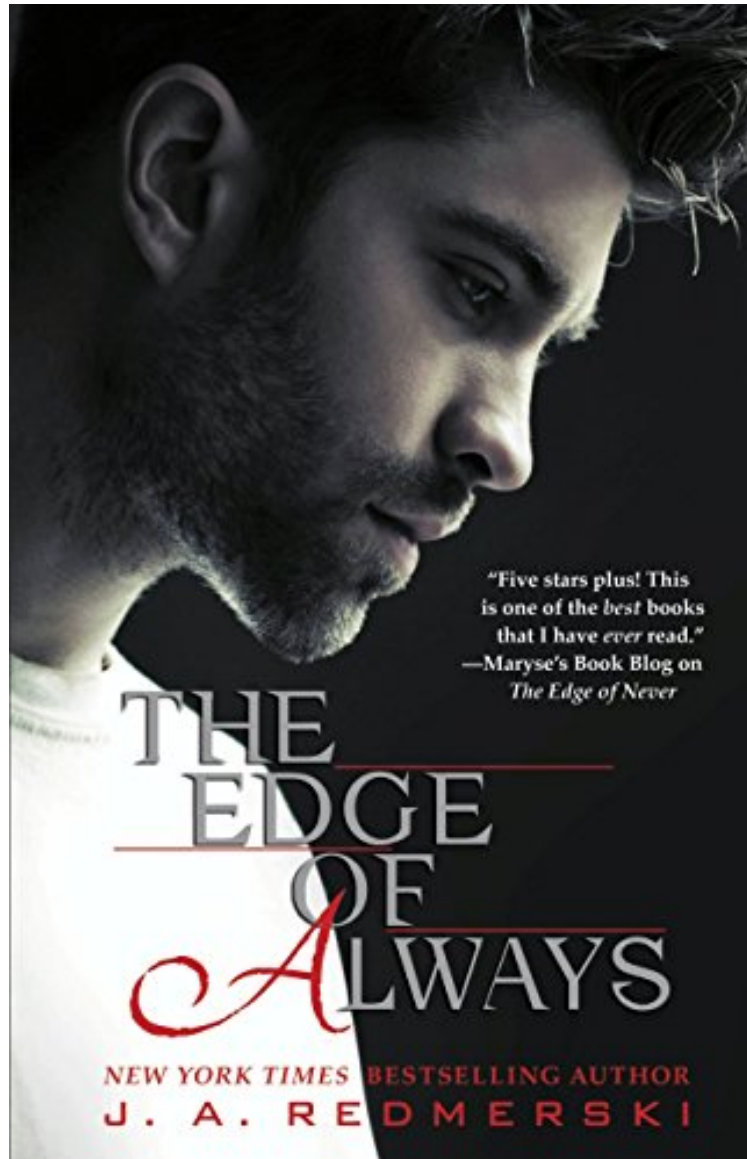

Not they get to tell the rest of their story and I have to say that isn't as exciting as the first part. Andrew and Cam try to live their happily ever after, decide where they want to live and what they want to do to earn some money. But fate still has a few surprises in store and not all of them are pleasant. They have to take hits again and decide to go back on the road. (I can't even say more about the story without spoiling too much AND because there isn't much more to say about the story.) The book is narrated from both, Andrew's and Camryn's, POV. But I felt that the book is mostly about Cam and her feelings. Andrew just agrees with everything she decides, he'd be happy with anything. And also the tragedy that is hinted at in the blurb, it's not important how Andrew copes, it's just about Cam's reaction. I won't tell you anything about it, but honestly, I think anyone can predict it already. And I also thought it wasn't THAT dramatic. After only a few weeks, Andrew decides that Cam is completely broken and takes her back on the road. But I don't think anyone would get over something like that in only a few weeks. So again... nothing special there. There were a few truly magical moments that made me cry like a baby. I still feel a lot for those two so they probably get a lot of brownie points just out of loyalty to the author. Especially Andrew is just so incredible. The things he does and say are nothing short of beautiful and would bring every woman to her knees. And I can really picture him looking like the handsome guy on the cover. His need to protect Cam wasn't like the typical alpha male drive. Or maybe it was, but he was the first man who's also able to explain it to me. In the second half, the author jumped forward in time pretty often and we only get glimpses and short scenes from the couple's life as we move through their story. It wasn't enough to get me really engaged in things and I was so so disappointed by that. Overall, I loved reading their story but I'm wondering whether the second book was worth telling at all.
