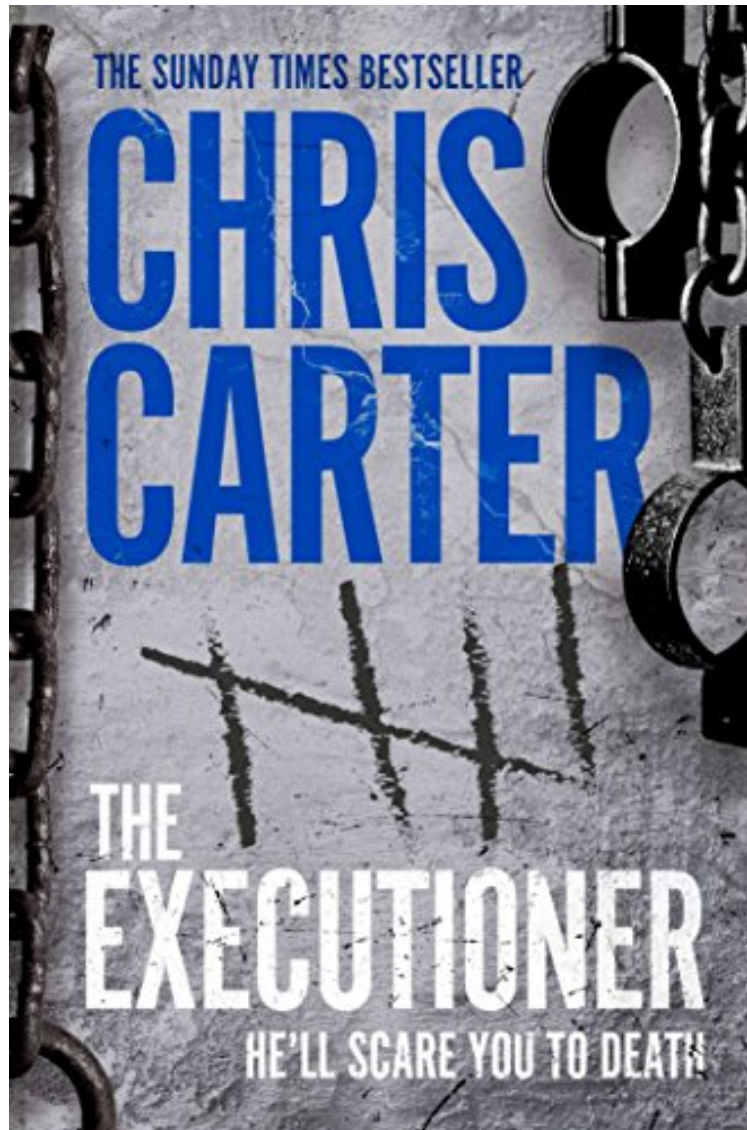

Von Wombatsbooks Detectives Robert Hunter and Carlos Garcia are on the hunt for a killer who tortures his victims sadistically before they die. The first victim that came to the attention of the police was the decapitated body of a priest, carefully positioned on the altar steps of a church. His head had been replaced by that of a dog. Police believe that it was a ritualistic killing but then more bodies are found. There does not seem to be any connection whatsoever between the victims. Police are not only at a loss but also get dubbed "The tarot cops" because the press has got wind of the involvement of a girl with extrasensory perception. Pressure is high, the killer needs to be found fast... When picking up "The Executioner" I wasn't aware that it is a follow-up to The Crucifix Killer. One can very well read this one as a stand-alone, at least I did not feel as if I had missed out on anything crucial from the first book. Other than outer appearances Carter dispenses characteristics of his protagonists sparsely, but wisely. Detectives Hunter and Garcia seem to be a blend of Carter himself: Bentz holds a PhD in forensic psychology and did his PhD-thesis on criminal behavior and conduct (Carter studied psychology with specialization in criminal behavior and worked as a criminal psychologist for several years), Garcia is of Brazilian descent a whiz kid (Carter moved to the US after finishing high school in Brazil). Carter certainly knows how to grab and hold the readers' attention: Although there is quite a bit of forensics, he does not go too scientific on his readers but explains everything in simple terms. His writing is extremely fluent, the plot is clever (boy was I wrong!), chapters are no longer than five pages and the level of suspense is high from page one right through the end. His style of writing reminded me a bit of James Patterson way back when his Alex Cross- novels used to be well written page-turners. If you think that Slaughter is too graphic, pls. stay away from this one, because "The Executioner" does not spare you gory details, but it is worth cringing through every single one of it! An easy, gripping unputdownable read! Have already (pre-) ordered the first in this series and also the follow-up The Night Stalker, which will be out sometime in July. Can't wait to get my hands on them!
