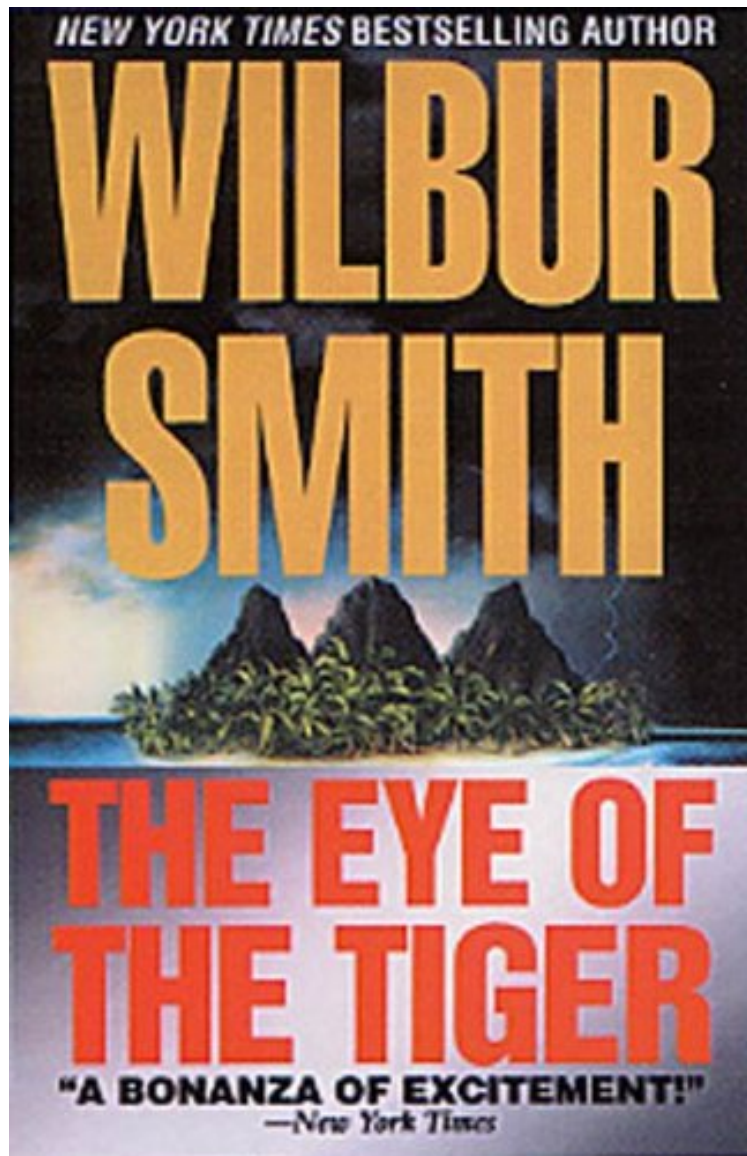

I found the gun injuries a little hard to stomach (but luckily most of the characters could handle major wounds) the rest was a super story, that kept me turning the pages... and just when I thought he was about to round off the story, the twists set in. The diving scenes are tense (and I loved the sharks), the reef descriptions are beautiful and the boat chase is quick. The "bad guy" is as horrible as you could make him without him becoming kitsch.
