If you can't stomach rape and violence, stay clear of this book!My thoughts:Honestly, this book was a little too extreme for me. The summary made it obvious that this wasn't going to be a fluffy, happy story, but I didn't mind. Normally I can easily stomach dark and twisted stories about rape and violence, but something about this story was just too much for me, making me feel utterly miserable throughout the whole book.To me, this isn't really a work of erotica. Sure, there's oodles of explicit sex, but I didn't find any of that even remotely erotic. At one point, I decided to just stop looking for the erotic in this

story and start concentrating on Nikolai's twisted mind games. These mind games were really fascinating. As the summary says, Nikolai's main goal is to break the connection between the two brothers, otherwise he won't be able to break them down into the perfect sex slaves he sells to his rich customers. Since the authors chose to use the POV of all three protagonists, you could follow the games from the very beginning (the idea) and the very end (the final consequences on the brothers). I couldn't stand Nikolai in the least. He's utterly convinced he's doing his victims a great favour by training them, since everybody outside the Flesh Cartel isn't a real human and behaves like a wild animal. And he's not a rapist either, if you ask him, because he always gives them a choice between sex and very painful consequences. But that's not much of a choice to me. I really felt sorry for Douglas and Mathias, though it was admittedly also fascinating to watch their slow breaking and rebuilding into what Nikolai wants them to be and how Nikolai achieved that. To sum it up, this was definitely a well written book, which I personally found way too disturbing and depressing. It made me feel completely miserable and haunted my dreams. I still gave 3 stars since a book rarely has such a big effect on me.
