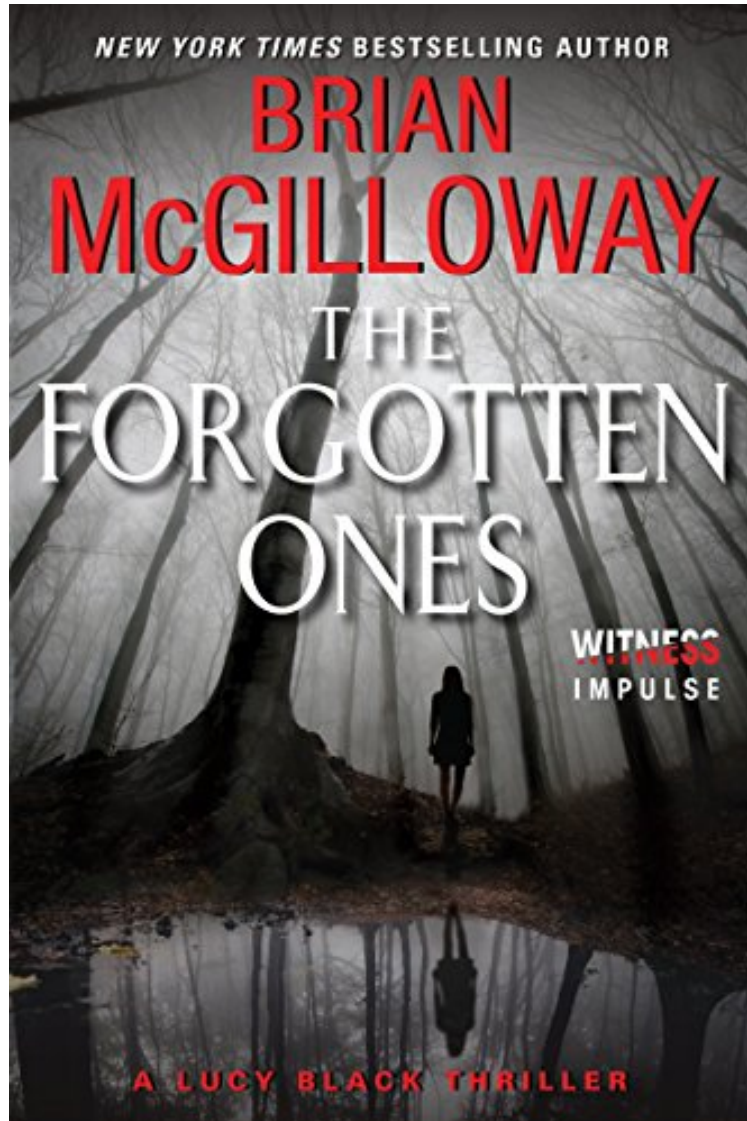

involve her father, who is losing his whole personality and memory to the wicked Alzheimer illness. Others her mother - a ACC aka very highranking Officer in the Northern Ireland Police, who once put her career high above her next-of-kin. Also her boy-friend Robbie, who has been badly injured in a bomb attack which was meant for Lucy. And her neighbors - a couple with children with a sister who is suffering not only physical but much more psychological abuse inflicted by a partner who is a real control-freak. And all the problems do not finish here...After an old man is fished without signs of life out of the river, a post-mortem has to be done. And to the great surprise of all involved, the man not only had yet been dead for a while - but embalmed, too! Ready for a funeral. But obviously someone had a very strong motive to use his cremation to resolve a very big personal problem. The investigation is moving Lucy and her colleagues more and more into the circles where the homeless - the forgotten ones - are situated. People who eat at charity soup-kitchens, drink the days away with cheap booze and sleep at the best in barricaded houses no-one uses any more. Or in the open...One of those homeless men is found dead at the waste depository - that what remains of him. The waste of the bin he was in has been dumped into a waste-carrier and has been compressed on the way to the final destination. An ugly view! Has he simply slept in that bin, and was carried away simply like that? There is a post-mortem on his body, too. And his body speaks of regular abuse. Illegal work is discovered. And evil persons - "human beings" is way to good a word for them - are found out, too. Who not only use the poor to exploit them without mercy, but punish every supposed rebellion without any compassion. And the death is not the worst that those beasts are capable to deliver. There are other sidelines, other crimes, but they all are coming together. The showdown at the very end is pure suspense. And Lucy makes some decisions for her future...Another very interesting book in the series about DS Lucy Black and her colleagues of the Derry Police in Northern Ireland. Which made me shudder, sometimes. The capacity of some persons to make a living on the backs of others knows no limit, it seems. A real good read for all those who like their police investigations with a very good plot and a lot of twists and turns.
