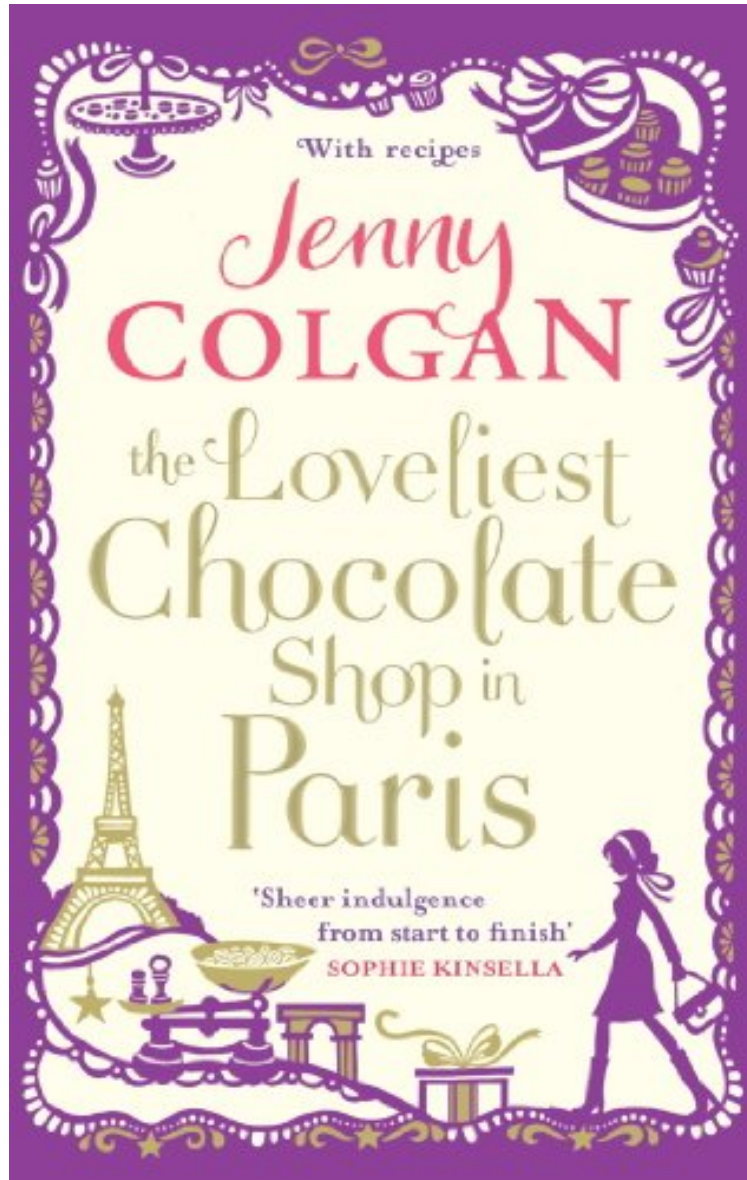

But ever since I had discovered Talking to Addison years ago in our local bookshop I have read every book of her (and of course, I did buy Amanda's wedding immediately after finishing Addison). Until this one. And I had high expectations of this book because I love Paris and I am also addicted to chocolate. But I did not like the book. I read it some time ago, and do not remember exactly what I did not appreciate - but I recall that in the beginning it was boring - the Story took up pace slowly although it was predictable, and that the Topics of death and illness were not too enjoyable. But most of all, I wished that Jenny would finally not write again another book about a young nice girl in her late twenties who changes her life and starts a business in producing or selling sweet delicious things. This was the third one in a row and - I hate to say it - but I got somehow bored. When Beach street bakery appeared, I did not buy it - I was just fed up with sweet things. I have just written in my (German) review of Cupcake Caf that I wish so much, that Jenny would write something different again (in former times I had not the impression that her books resembled each other so much) - something a bit more funny, even a bit weird and malicious. And that I still have hope because now there are not so many businesses left she has not treated yet (except for a restaurant where they serve delicious desserts, perhaps), but that I fear that she could also write about a organic little farm, a shop of antiques or a hotel. And after finishing writing the review I just thought : Give it a try and look if there is something new of her: And I have discovered that a) the "Beach Street Bakery" was already in 2014, b) there is an new preview for a book in 2016 - about a bookshop (! :- (oh yes, I have not thought about THAT possibility, but it is not so different from a shop of antiques) and c) there is another book in 2015 - which seems to be quite different ! :-)) So there still is hope. 1 von 1 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich.
