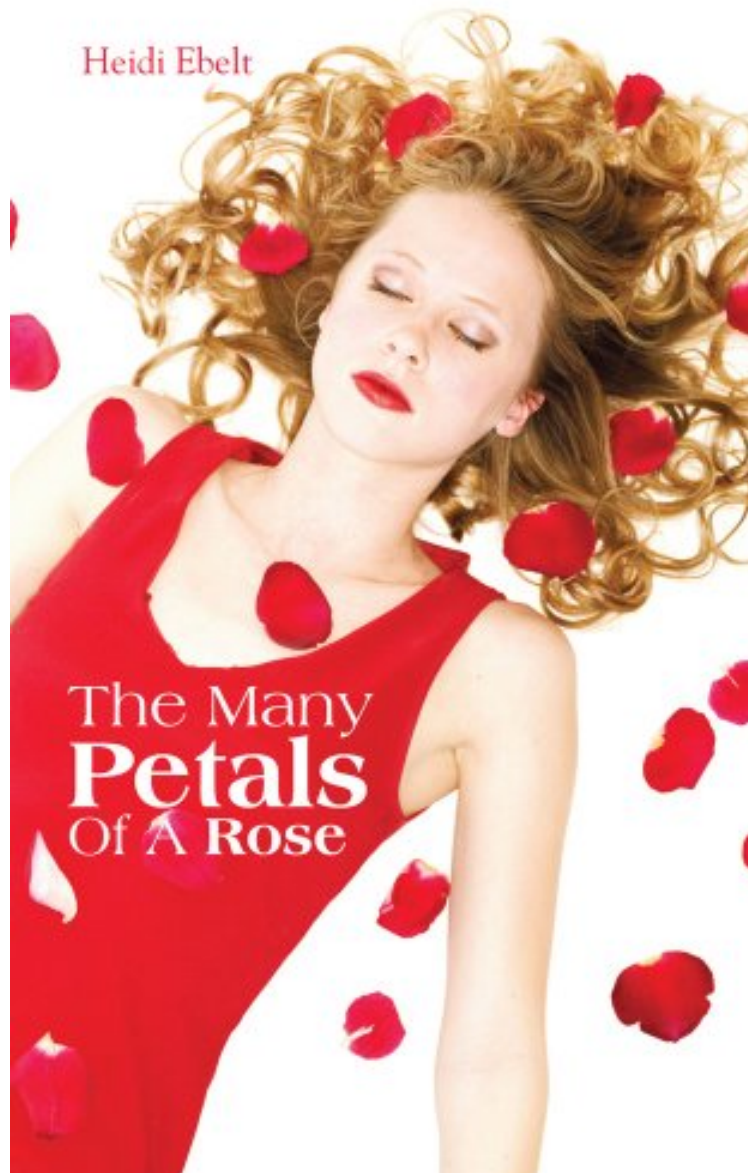

Ein außerordentlich interessant und spannend geschriebenes Buch. Es beschreibt den Lebenslauf und die Erlebnisse eines jungen Mädchens namens "Rose", welches in den Jahren nach 1940 im späteren West-Berlin aufwuchs. Die geschilderten Begebenheiten und alle von der Hauptfigur "Rose" gewonnenen Eindrücke stammen aus dem Berlin der Nachkriegsjahre um 1950 bis 1960. Sie können vom Leser, der selber in dieser Zeit Berlin erlebte, voll bestätigt werden. Die Autorin hat mit ihren Schilderungen aus dem Leben der "Rose" die Stimmung der Jugend der damaligen Zeit voll getroffen. Diese bewegte sich in einem Bergang zwischen den Traditionen berlieferter Werte aus einem diktatorischen Regime in einen demokratischen Staat und allen damit verbundenen Freiheiten und Pflichten. Dies beinhaltete damals den großen Nachholbedarf versumter Erfahrungen und Freiheiten der jungen Generation, welche letztlich später in den 60-er und 70-er Jahre zum Aufbegehren gegen berlieferte Führungsstrukturen führte. Das Buch kann allen jungen Leuten und besonders der zeitnahen lateren Generation wärmstens zum Lesen empfohlen werden.
