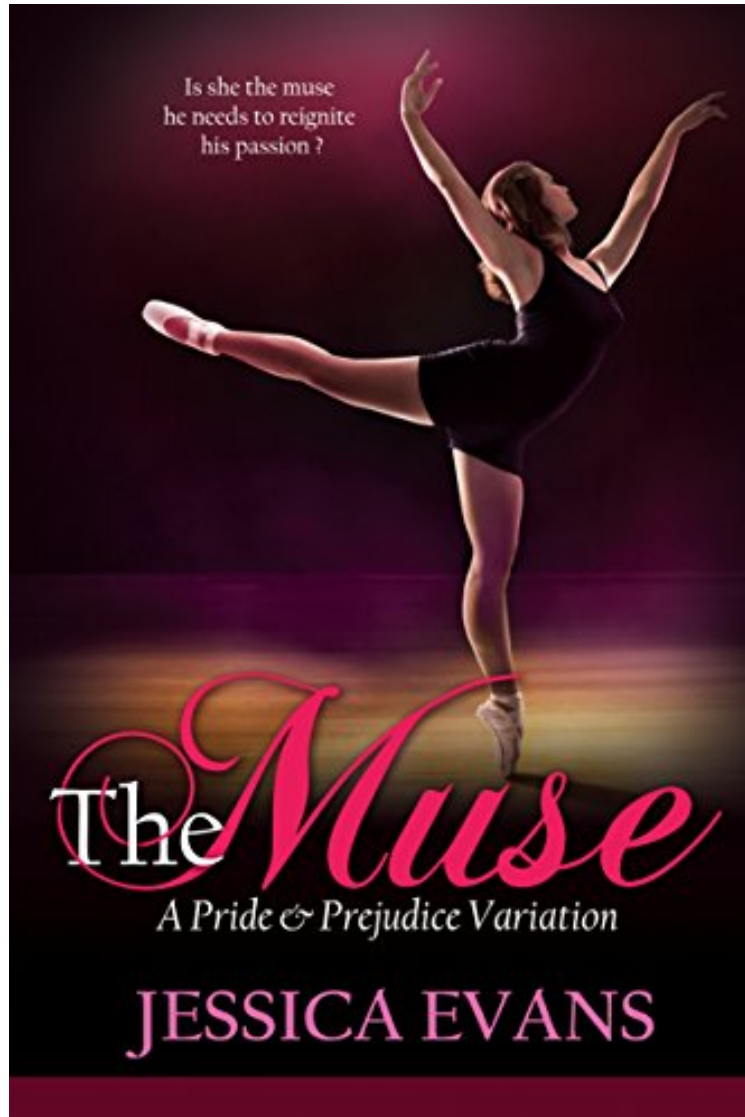

In this variation Lizzy is mostly angry and confused about her feelings toward Darcy, but as always love will triumph. Personally I was taken aback to find out the age difference between them (13) and I would have like to given more insight into Darcy's character (why doesn't he drink, the reallationship with his father,

etc) but it is quite easy (as always) to fall for a dancing Darcy. Particularly I was not fond of the spelling errors, but nothing that can not be mended with a good proof reading and an attentive editor. I recommend this book to any PP fanatic, but not to Austen's purists; there is use of adult language and sex scenes (though in flashbacks)
