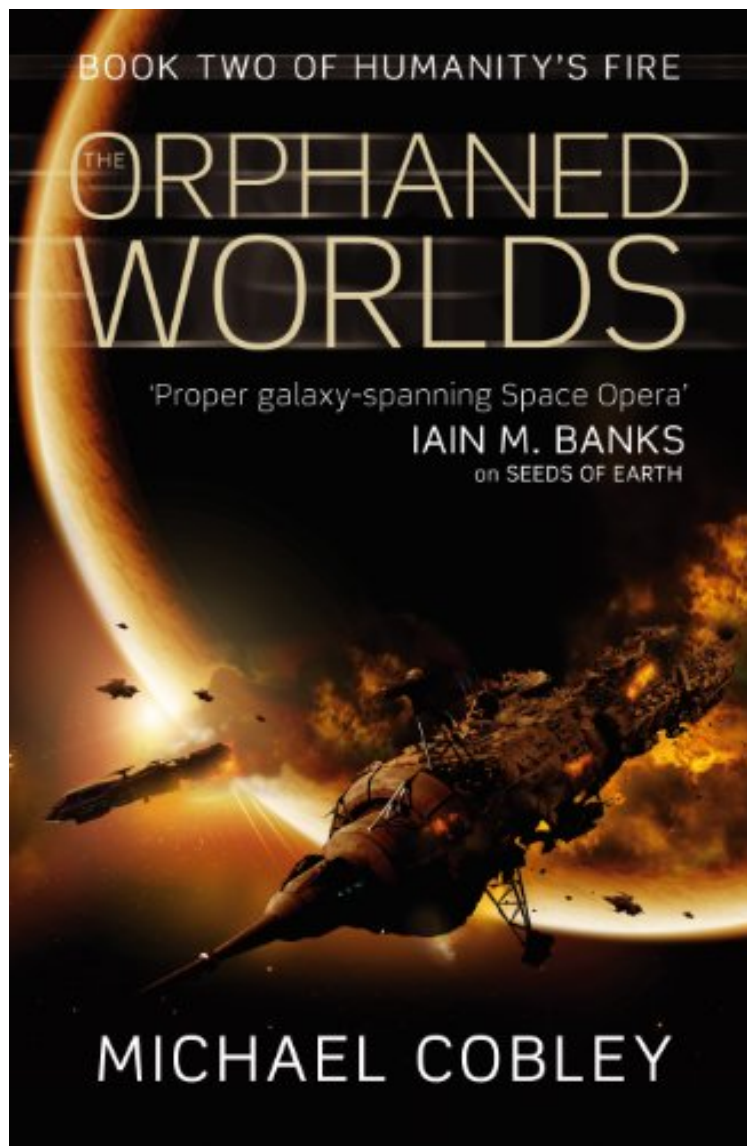

Bruce Sterling, Charles Stross, Transformers, Hamilton et al. However there are also some new elements involved like the hyperspace layer prisons. MC is also learning quickly. He included a very helpful list of Characters and races in his second book. His approach towards technology like hyperspace jumps and light speed travel is flawless without annoying readers with stupid tech talks. Some of his main characters especially Greg, Chel and Cat miss wit and depth which is a weakness of the series. And there are clearly too much Scots involved. With Orphaned Worlds he is getting closer to Iain Banks. I am looking forward to his third book now.
